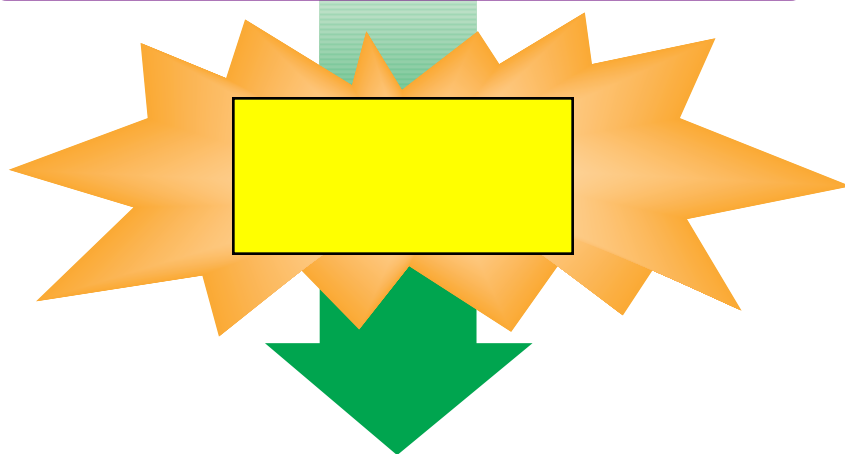


Chapter 5: Cause and Effect
