

1845 American Culture Fair DIRECTIONS

1. Imagine you are in charge of publicity for a three-day American Culture Fair in 1845. The fair features presentations by poets, writers of fiction and non-fiction, and artists featured in Chapter 14, Section 2.
2. You will create a poster advertising the fair. Posters should highlight at least one individual who will present his or her work, including biographical information and samples of his or her work.
3. Make sure your facts are accurate and use visuals **directly related** to the person you have chosen. Extra credit will be awarded to those students who type AND print their poster in color. Use the examples below to assist you with creating the style and feel of your poster.
